Parents, Guardians and/or cottage managers will be notified if there is any violation of the policy.

Residential Students

A St. Christopher resident who brings these items to school will report to their Assistant Principal to turn it in or be sent to the AOD to turn it in.

Day Students

Day students must leave these items with their bus monitor or turn them in when they enter school in the morning. The item will be returned at dismissal when the student boards the school bus.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE TURNED IN. THIS IS A ZERO TOLERANCE RULE. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.

Anyone violating this rule will meet with their Assistant Principal to discuss when and how their item or items will be returned.

STUDENT DRESS CODE PROTOCOL:

Student dress must be appropriate. Use the following guidelines to select your clothing.

- a. **Headgear** of any kind must be removed immediately upon entering the building. Bandanas and ‘do-rags’ are not permitted at any time.
- b. **Beads** of any kind are not permitted on students’ body or hair.
- c. **Footwear** must protect your feet. Slippers and flip flops do not sufficiently protect feet and therefore are not permitted in school. Students are not permitted to wear Stiletto heels (4” or more). Only sneakers are permitted in the gymnasium.
- d. **Pants/shorts** must be worn at the waist.
- e. **Clothing** that displays tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, vulgarity or sexual innuendos are not permitted.
- f. **Provocative attire** is **not** allowed. This includes, but is not limited to, “revealing” tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, mesh shirts or midriff shirts. Spaghetti straps (dresses or shirts) are not permitted. Skirts or shorts more than 3 ½ inches above the knee or which have revealing holes/slits are not permitted.
- g. **Outerwear** may not be worn in the building. This includes, but is not limited to, coats, hats, gloves or scarves.
