College Now is a collaborative program of the City University of New York (CUNY)/Office of Academic Affairs and the New York City Department of Education. College Now offers many activities and opportunities:

- academic courses (both for high school and college credit)
- campus-based tours and cultural events, such as theater or dance performances
- exclusive scholarship offers
