## Middle School Field Trip Incentive Program



## Aim

To increase student performance by offering students hands on experiences outside of the classroom. Students will be rewarded for performance both in the classroom and throughout the entire school.

## Program Description

The program will include eight trips, six of which have an academic approach and two of which will be recreational. The trips will take place during the months of October, November, December, February, March, April and May.

## Participation

Students will be selected to participate on a month-by-month basis and will be evaluated in the following targeted areas:

- Attendance

- Behavior

- Homework

- Classwork

Teachers and staff will discuss each students' performance on an individual basis and determine which students are able to participate.

## Cost

All efforts have been made to keep the field trips limited to low-cost destinations. For certain trips students may be asked to contribute to the cost of the trip. No students will be prevented from going due to inability to pay.
